Hubbard's Policy Updates

Alcohol, Tobacco, Illicit Drugs and Other Substances Policy

Hubbard's School has a zero tolerance policy towards student use, possession, sale and distribution of alcohol, tobacco, vaping products, e-cigarettes and illicit drugs, related instruments and other substances whilst on school grounds or at school-related activities. View the full Policy

Dress Code Policy

Hubbard's School is a non-uniform school, however students are expected to maintain acceptable dress standards. Non-compliance with the dress code will be considered a failure to comply with school procedures and direct consequences will result.

All students are required to ensure that shirts and tops must be long enough to keep the mid-body covered, and necklines of shirts and tops must provide adequate coverage and be suitable for a workplace. Skirts and shorts must be long enough to allow adequate coverage, and undergarments should never be visible. Garments carrying inappropriate (e.g. obscene or derogatory) images or words, promoting alcohol, tobacco or illegal substances are not acceptable. Enclosed footwear is preferred. Footwear (such as thongs) that pose a workplace health and safety risk are not permitted.

August Exam Block

Hubbard's final internal Exam Block is fast approaching and we encourage all students to continue reviewing their study notes, review the work on MATRIX and seek assistance if needed.

Exams will occur from 24 August - 31 August. This is an exam block and as such, students will only have to attend on days they have an exam scheduled unless their teachers have made arrangements with them to run additional classes in preparation for the end-of-year exams.

Mornings Exams:

- AARA students begin at 8am
- Non-AARA students begin at 9am

Afternoon Exams:

ALL STUDENTS begin at 1:15pm

We encourage all students to look at their exam timetable carefully and let us know if any clashes have occurred that we've missed.

Please ensure all calculators are free of any graffiti, pictures, writing etc. before the August exams. This is due to the strict regulations QCAA hold which will apply for the QCAA final exams. This applies to all subjects where a calculator may be used. Please also familiarise yourself with how to clear your calculator as this is another requirement by QCAA. If you are unsure of how to do this, please seek guidance from your teacher.
