Senior Prep Year

Our Senior Prep Year is growing, in fact our enrolments have doubled in the last month!

The program is designed to increase students knowledge in both fundamental skills and advanced aspects of English, Mathematics and Science. This enables students to develop and refine these skills for success in Senior Schooling at Hubbard's.



What we are learning in Mathematics

Students are mastering the fundamentals of linear algebra and are on track to move into further complex trigonometry and higher power functions in the next few months.

What we are learning in Science

We are in the middle of completing a unit on genetics and evolution. The students are mastering concepts that will be revisited in Unit 4 of Year 12 - so these students are getting a two-year head start!

What we are learning in English

Our students are currently in the depths of reading 'The Dressmaker' by Rosalie Ham. The story is set in rural Australia in the 1950's and addresses the community response to the rapidly modernising post-World War II Australia. Whilst reading this story, our students have been learning the concepts of how to analyse and dissect text. In addition, they have been been focussing on perfecting their spelling, punctuation and grammar.

Giovanna (teacher) has been encouraging our students to join their local council Library and start/continue reading for pleasure. She has also directed them to a podcast called 'All Things Bookish' run by two young adults who explore new books and interview authors.
