

## **University Clinical Aptitude Test (UCAT)**

The University Clinical Aptitude Test (UCAT ANZ) is an admissions test used by the UCAT ANZ Consortium of universities in Australia and New Zealand for their medical, dental and clinical science degree programmes.

The test helps universities select applicants with the most appropriate abilities and professional behaviours required for new doctors and dentists to be successful in their clinical careers. This is used in collaboration with other admissions processes such as interviews and academic qualifications.

Students who intend to apply for degrees in Medicine, Dentistry and Clinical Science are encouraged to sit their UCAT test this year.

**Bookings close:** 17 May 2022 at 11:59pm AEST **Late bookings close:** 31 May 2022 at 11:59pm AEST

The 2022 UCAT ANZ must be sat between 1 July and 12 August 2022.

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## **Compass**

#### What is it?

In 2022, Hubbard's has adopted Compass as our school management system. All parents and guardians should have now received email communication along with their login details.

This application will allow us to better communicate with families, streamline our processes, ensure our data is safe and secure and provide an all-round better experience for students, staff and parents.

#### Reporting Attendance/Absences

The parent portal is our preferred option for reporting any absences for your student. This is very simple and can be completed through an app on your phone or through a web browser on your computer.

In the instance where your student has an unexplained absence, you will be notified that afternoon/evening to advise that your student was not present for one or more classes. This also provides you with the option to login to explain these absences.

#### **News Items**

The Compass News Feed appears on the Home page for all users (staff, students and parents), and is a great way to communicate within our school community.

The News Feed is customised to only apply notifications that are relevant to you and your student. The most recent News Items sit at the top and are moved down the feed as other posts are created (unless made a priority in which case it is pinned to the top of the Feed).

## **Report Cards & Parent / Teacher Interviews**

Parents will receive student report cards relating to the subjects they are currently enrolled in by early May.

Parents will then be invited to book parent and teacher interviews with their students' teachers. This is a great opportunity for you to meet your child's teacher and seek further information regarding your student's performance within the classroom.
