

Students may also consider organising a time to meet with Cathy about their QTAC applications if they would like to discuss their preferences or consider submitting an EAS.



QCAA Exam Block

Arriving on time

It's imperative that students arrive on time for their exams. This means arriving no later than 30 minutes prior to the exam start time so that you are prepared and the exam protocols setout by OCAA can be carried out.

Parking

For those students who drive to school, it would be advisable to make alternative arrangements for the QCAA block exams. The visitors' parking bays, as well as all other undercover parking for the building may be occupied by the Exam Supervisors and the QCAA invigilators. On street parking is a 2-hour limit but many of the exams will be 3 hours or more.

It is essential all students enrolling in 2022 have a thorough understanding of the options available next year before making their selection, therefore we encourage all parents and students to **virtually attend the Information Evening.**
