Exam Reminders

Arriving on time

It's imperative that students arrive on time for their exams. This means arriving no later than 30 minutes prior to the exam start time so that you are prepared and the exam protocols set by QCAA can be carried out.

Parking

For those students who drive to school, it is advisable to make alternative arrangements for the QCAA block exams. The visitors' parking bays, as well as all other undercover parking for the building may be occupied by the Exam Supervisors and the QCAA invigilators. On street parking is a 2-hour limit but many of the exams will be 3 hours or more.

ATAR Portal & Registration

Students who will be ATAR eligible this year, are able to register to access their ATAR result through the QTAC ATAR portal.

To register, students will need to provide their full name (as shown on your QCAA learning account), date of birth, LUI number and a personal email account.

Students' LUI numbers can be found on their school ID card. If you are unable to obtain this information, please see Hubbard's reception.

ATARs for 2021 Year 12 students will be released between 8am - 9am on Friday 17 December 2021.

2022 Enrolment Agreements

All returning students will have received their Enrolment Agreements for 2022 by now.

2022 is looking to be a great year with an exceptional amount of enrolments already secured. For those families looking to return but haven't had the chance to complete your students enrolment, we encourage you to complete this at your earliest convenience.

Due to the high demand on certain subjects, some subjects may need to be capped. This means those who enrol earlier may receive priority in their subject preferences.

For students entering their final year of school and wanting to complete the Diploma of Business in 2022, you must enrol in this course within the next few days. Late enrolments (after 5th November 2021) will not complete the Diploma in time to count the result for their ATAR in 2022.

As Deputy Principal, Janette will assist the Principal to facilitate improved support for our students and implement the strategic direction and growth of our school.

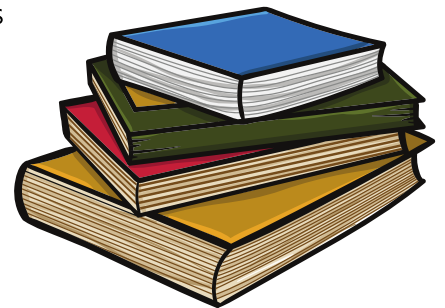
Janette comes to us with a highly qualified and experienced background in Special Education, Psychology, Careers Counselling and Educational Leadership.

In the past month, we have had the privilege of awarding certificates to two of our Hubbard's students on behalf of the University of Queensland Enhanced Studies Program.

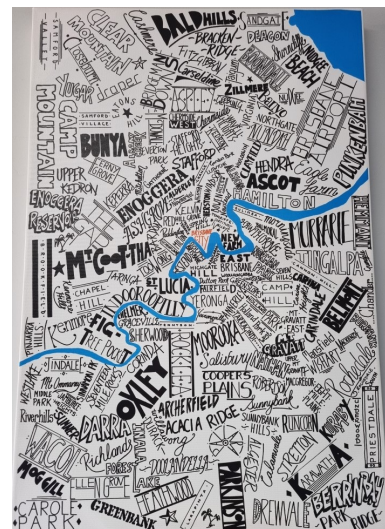
Both of these students have shown exceptional dedication to their studies and we are proud to count them as students within our Hubbard's community.

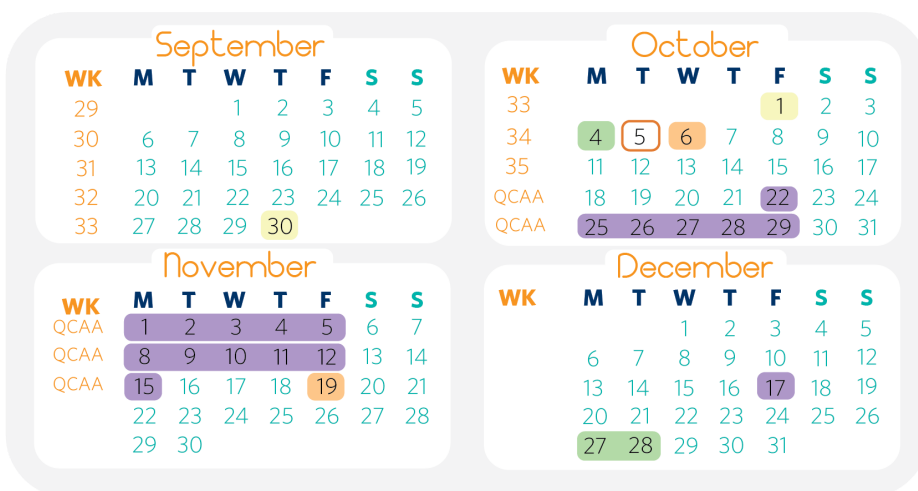
