

Giovanna's Holiday Reading

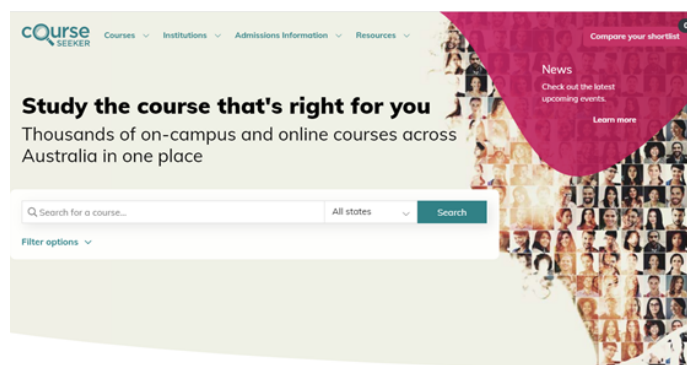
With the holidays fast approaching, and we're all wondering how to unplug our young people from socials, meme threads, and the dreaded X-box, I wanted to share with you a great online resource.

Reminders & Procedures



Absenteeism / Student Illness

If a student is sick, please call (07 3371 5999) or email (admin@hubbards.qld.edu.au) to advise they will not be attending school.

If we do not hear from the parents, we will email their guardians to advise of their students absence in the afternoon.

If a student is feeling unwell and wishes to leave, we will make contact with their guardians to inform them.

Early Departures/Late Arrivals

In the case that a student is required to depart class early, they are required to visit reception before the class commences to complete an 'early departure slip' which can be provided to their teacher. If a student is late, they are required to complete a 'late arrival slip' and provide this to their teacher.

Replacement of Student ID

In the case where a student misplaces their ID card and they need to order a replacement, please contact Hubbard's admin. The replacement fee is \$30 and this can be taken over the phone via credit card.

Coming Up

UCAT Test

If your student is interested in applying to complete the UCAT Test, this is a reminder that the application deadlines are fast approaching.

The UCAT is a two-hour computer-based test which assess a range of mental abilities identified by university medical and dental schools as important. It consists of five separately timed subtests which each contain a number of questions in a multiple-choice format.
