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Important Dates

SEE Registrations Now Open

On-time registration for the Senior External Examinations (SEE) opens today (1st June). *Payment and registrations are due to the QCAA by 30th June 2021.*

What do we need to do?

- 1. Look out for school email communication relating to Senior External Examinations.
- 2. Register your student for each exam they intend on sitting
- 3. Email the school your SEE Registration Confirmation email (this will enable us to cross reference with QCAA to ensure your student has been registered).

QCAA advises registrations received after 30th June 2021 will not be accepted unless there are exceptional and unavoidable circumstance.

QCAA AARA Applications

The QCAA recognises that some students may have disability impairment and/or medical conditions, or experience other circumstances that may be a barrier to their performance in assessment. Access arrangements and reasonable adjustments (AARA) are designed to assist these students.

What do we need to do?

The following documentation is required when submitting an AARA application:

- student statement (optional)
- medical report (essential)
- evidence of verified disability
- school statement (completed by Principal upon receiving the medical report)

The Medical Report needs to be completed by medical professional and/or allied health professionals such as Speech Pathologists, Occupational Therapists and Psychologists.

Please note: QCAA will not accept any Medical Reports dated prior to 1st May 2021.

When is it due?

If you are applying for special provisions through the AARA process, please ensure that the completed forms are returned to the school no later than the 30 June 2021.

All new and returning students who are requesting special provisions for exam conditions need to complete these forms.
